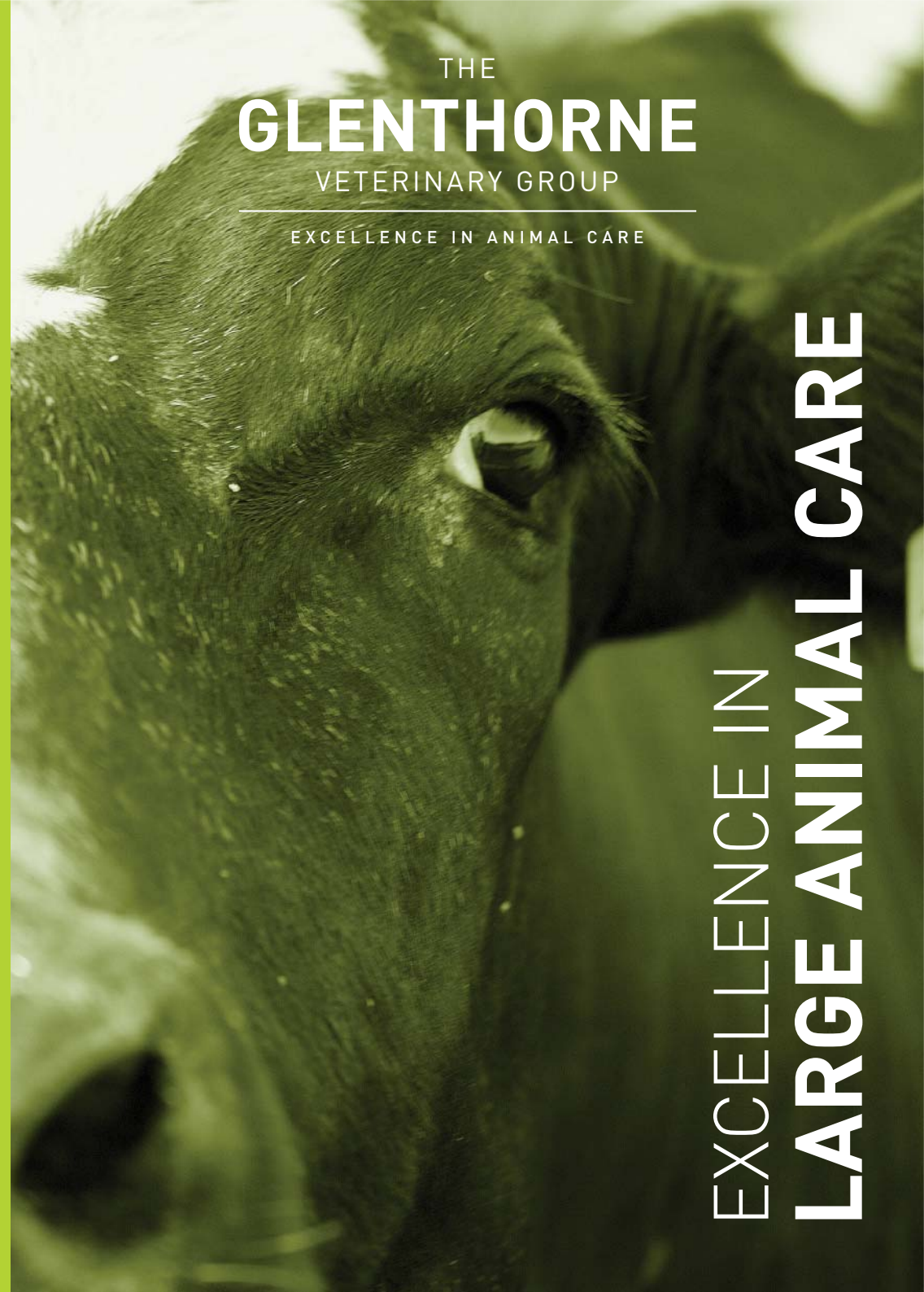

HERD / FLOCK HEALTH

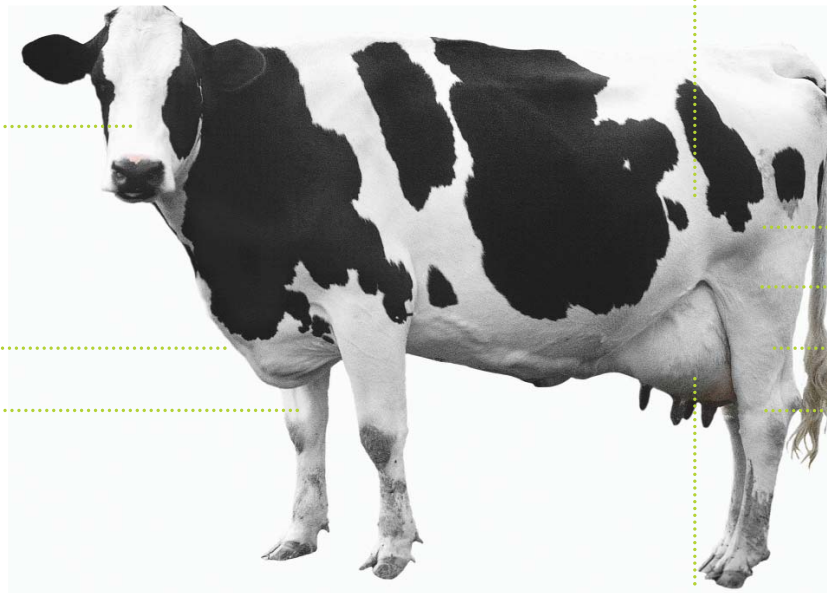
Our extensive experience and expertise allows us to give both advice and provide solutions to any herd / flock health problems.
